There's a disconnect between our concept of hope, and the biblical concept of hope. And as a result, many are missing out on the blessing of hope.

We say things like, "I hope it doesn't rain tomorrow," or "I hope I don't get a cold this winter." And even though we hope for those things, our hope has absolutely no bearing on how things will turn out. It may still rain; we may still catch a cold.

Our concept of hope is an uncertain one. That's the normal way in which we understand hope.

But the biblical concept of hope is the complete opposite to that. Take a moment to drink this in:

Through our faith, Christ has brought us into that blessing of God's grace that we now enjoy. And we are very happy because of the hope we have of sharing God's glory. And we are also happy with the troubles we have. Why are we happy with troubles? Because we know that these troubles make us more patient. And this patience is proof that we are strong. And this proof gives us hope. And this hope will never disappoint us. We know this because God has poured out his love to fill our hearts through the Holy Spirit he gave us. (Romans 5:2-5 - emphasis mine).



The biblical concept of hope is certain hope - the sort that comes in Christ and Christ alone. So ... the next time you read that word "hope" in the Bible, replace it in your mind with the words "certain hope" because that's the meaning that God intends for you to receive into your heart.

No matter what's going on in your life, no matter how dark, how bad things get, you have an absolutely certain hope of a wonderful future, an eternity, in Christ.

May hope rise in your heart today as you receive God's Word.
