Such a revelation caused John to include love as a compelling theme throughout his writing. John tells us that God is love and that real love comes from God (1 Jn 4:7-8). In the same breath, he also tells us that whoever does not love does not genuinely know God. If we know Jesus - the Jesus that John knew - then his love must rub off on us. What a challenging statement! Very challenging, but oh so necessary.

As Jesus' disciples today, we still need this reminder to love one another. It is so easy to criticise other people, other churches and pastors. Social media is awash with criticism and opinions about churches and pastors! I firmly believe that critiquing of other peoples' ministry practice or doctrine only has a place in a context of relationship. I know of churches whose leaders I know, love and respect, and yet others have had a negative experience in their church. The truth is that no church is free from imperfections. We are all a work in progress, and we only "know in part" as Paul says (1 Cor. 13:12). We are commanded to love; to be kind, patient and forgiving, to be encouraging and not critical. That is how people will recognise the distinctive character of Jesus amongst us - loving God is made visible by how we love one another (1 Jn 4:20-21). Let us not fail to be obedient to Jesus in this vital part of the Christian life.

Two of the key members of our staff are Werner Egger and Alan Sharpham. Werner is General Manager and Alan currently has the role of Content Director and Production Manager.


Werner Egger
