This identity is in contrast to being previously recognised as a 'Christian radio station' or 'Christian Community radio station'. This approach is more inclusive as not all people in our community identify as Christian, but all belong to a family in one form or another. Rhema's newly re-framed identity has a more relational perspective (family) to potentially reach more people with the gospel message. It also aligns with Rhema's current positioning statement, *'We're for families'*.

To the family of believers, the expanded version is... *'Rhema 99.9 is a family radio station that broadcasts the love of Jesus Christ and the hope found in Him'*. This will provide a sense of assurance to the Christian community regarding Rhema's ministry to fulfil its vision and mission.

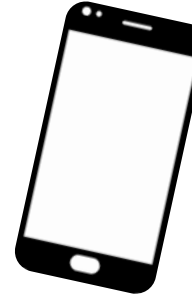
STREAMING... Why?

You can hear Rhema anywhere the Internet is available! If you have the Internet then you can stream Rhema on your device. But why stream? Because during those occasions we go off air you can still listen through your device. But more-so, when you're away from our region you can tune in on your device as if you were still in the area.

How do I stream?

On your **computer** or **tablet** go to the Rhema website (rhema999.com.au) and click 'Listen Online'. If you have a bluetooth speaker it is likely to sound better than your computer speaker.

On your **phone**, download the free 'Simple Radio' app and search for 'Rhema 99.9' in the app. If your car has bluetooth you should be able to stream it through your car radio. And don't forget to take your bluetooth speaker - it'll definitely sound better than your phone speaker!



Shazam It!

Shazam is a free app, not just a Superhero. You can find out what music Rhema is currently playing by using Shazam on your phone. It's a free download that 'listens' to what you're listening to and shows you the name of the song, artist and album it's from.

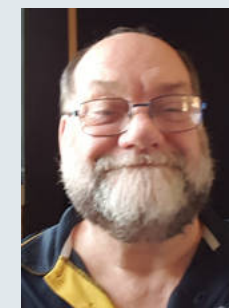

John Sedman

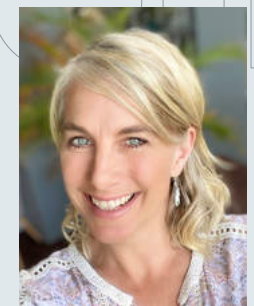
