### God's Word

#### with Samuel Gittins



Samuel Gittins is Pastor of Wauchope Presbyterian Church and presents 'Conversations with Samuel' on Rhema 99.9 Tuesday nights at 7:15pm and just after 6am Sunday mornings.

In God's Word, read or proclaimed, we meet Jesus and learn all we need to live a life pleasing to God. However, the human heart is stubborn and rebellious so reading God's Word can be hard work and to hear Him speak to us through his Word is, quite frankly, a miracle!

#### Two things:

Firstly, pray. We pray that God would, by His Spirit, help us want to read His Word and that our hearts would be teachable. As God works in us through His Spirit by His Word we will grow in our delight of God's Word. (I've never met an old and mature believer who did not discipline themselves in God's Word and who did not also come to love reading it.)

Secondly, we put in the hard work of understanding the Bible. There are two things we can recognise to help us understand the Bible better: everything we read points to the provision of God's grace or our need for God's grace (or both). As we read we ask ourselves, "How does this passage help me understand my need for God's grace (mercy, forgiveness, compassion, patience etc.) AND how does this passage help me understand how God provides His grace." And always, we see our need and God's provision of grace satisfied perfectly in Jesus

Let me encourage you to pray and reflect on God's grace as we read the Gospel of Mark together in Conversations with Samuel.
