We're in this Together!



Every year, Rhema 99.9 sets aside two months for financial appeals to keep the station running. They are usually in June and November. This year, the theme of our June Appeal is "We're in this Together" and we're asking you to get behind us with a donation as we work together to broadcast God's love to our region **24 hours a day**. And remember, all donations \$2 or more attract a tax deduction.

This is also our 'licensing year' when the government decides whether or not to extend our broadcasting licence for another five years. Membership numbers factor into this decision.

Membership Drive

In March, our membership drive helped boost the number of members of Rhema 99.9 by a very healthy 101 (as at the end of March) and is still growing. Thank you to all those who renewed their membership or became new members.

We have also instituted a 'subscriber' model for those who enjoy listening to Rhema 99.9 but without the full

requirements of membership (signing of the Statement of Faith & being a regular Church attender). So if any of your unchurched friends are regular listeners to Rhema, they can become subscribers for just \$10 per year. This provides them with the quarterly newsletter and program guide, enabling them to keep up with what Rhema's doing.

Licence Renewal

Rhema's broadcasting licence is due for renewal this year and we have until the end of May to prove to the government that you want this radio station to stay on the air. As a special offer, and because membership numbers are a sign of local support, Rhema 99.9 has reduced fees to just \$10 for new and renewed memberships until June 2025.

If you are still not a member, or your membership has lapsed, please give serious thought to becoming a member or updating your membership. This can be done online at rhema999.com.au/membership or by phoning Rhema on 6584 1246 Tuesday to Friday during business hours.

This is urgent if you want family-friendly radio to continue in our community.

NEW PROGRAMS

We have 2 new programs starting soon. The first is "Forget-Me-Not", a program focusing on dementia, and hosted by local dementia worker, Anne Elliott. The program will provide listeners with information on dementia and dementia care, support carers of those with dementia and conduct interviews with people with dementia, carers and professionals in the field. "Forget-Me-Not" can be heard on Rhema 99.9 at 7:10pm Tuesdays.

Another new program is our Breakfast Session from 7 to 10am weekdays. It's called "The Daily with Cam Want" and has been on air since early April. Cam currently hosts the TCM Update which is a music news program heard on Rhema 99.9 at 10pm Friday nights and just after the 11am news on Saturdays. This replaces the Luke & Susie Show which finished just before Easter.



HOW (NOT) TO RUN A CHRISTIAN RADIO STATION:

- 1) Play only music heard in Church, like hymns and worship music.
- 2) Don't play any songs that don't mention the name of Jesus at least once.
- 3) Play a wide variety of music interspersed all day that will reach both young and old.
- 4) Play at least one hymn every hour.
- 5) Fill the schedule with talk programs.
- 6) Don't pay anyone including management (they should all work by faith).
- 7) Keep away from social media (because it's all of the devil).

What is Rhema 99.9's answer to these "rules"?

- Radio must have a target audience. No one will listen to a station that plays heavy rock one minute and a hymn the next.
- We want to present music that will reach both young and old, and this is best done by presenting specific times for youth and seniors.
- ➤ A balance of music between overtly Christian and those with positive lyrics but not necessarily "God-centred", is much more likely to achieve the result of encouraging unchurched listeners to think positively about God and feeling included.
- While talk programs are important, those who just want to listen to radio for the music will leave Rhema on, knowing it is safe when their children can hear it

- and provides a pleasant mix of music. Rhema's target audience is the family with primary age children. But plenty of other people have told us they like it too!
- Pay peanuts and get monkeys. Would you work for nothing? Then why expect others to? Even Christians have mortgages or rent to pay. And most need to eat daily. Remember, "the labourer is worthy of his hire" (see Luke 10:7 & 1 Tim 5:18).
- ➤ Yes, there's a lot wrong with social media. But there's also a lot of good content reaching out and proclaiming the Gospel. While the devil does use social media, so does God. Have you checked out Rhema's Facebook pages?
